



Bridgewater Mill's Refreshed Look & New Wines

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Bridgewater Mill has a bold new look and a newly extended wine range. Renowned for world-class Sauvignon Blanc, Bridgewater Mill is now making a lifted Pinot Grigio & crisp Rosé, alongside their Viognier & Chardonnay and rich smooth Shiraz.

Made by the Petaluma winemaking team, Bridgewater Mill is focussed on producing cool climate Adelaide Hill's wines. Winemaker Peter Dredge says, "The new Pinot Grigio and Rosé are true to style, with crisp natural acids and clear varietal characters. We take a gentle and non-intrusive winemaking approach to lock in freshness and best reflect the Adelaide Hills grapes in the bottle".

Bridgewater Mill wines have always been about the fresh, clean taste of the Adelaide Hills and the new labels reflect this. The front label of each bottle is but one panel of a larger composition of the Adelaide Hills. Artist Brenton Hill has created an original piece of work using ink to capture the horizon line of the region with its arcs and gullies. The result is an impression that embodies the spirit of the wine and of the Adelaide Hills.

The unique combination of the Adelaide Hill's chilly climate, diverse soils and natural elevation all play a major part in making the Bridgewater Mill wines. When coupled with the winemaking team's integrity and focus on preserving the cool, crisp fruit from vineyard to bottle, what ends up on your table is a sophisticated yet simple wine designed to be enjoyed and shared.
